Hong Kong native, **Winnie Nip** is Resident Artist with Opera Company of Brooklyn and will be appearing as Papagena in the *Magic Flute* in June, 2012. She will also be singing Voce dal cielo in *Don Carlos* at the Met Opera Guild in May. Winnie has sung numerous roles including Blondchen, Susanna, Olympia, La Fée, Romilda, Galatea, Gilda, Sophie, Violetta, Mélisande, Juliette and Giannetta. Upcoming roles include Pamina, Papagena, and Amor with One World Symphony in New York. She has also performed extensively as an oratorio and concert soloist. Ms. Nip graduated with honours from Harvard University and with Associate of Trinity College London diplomas in voice, violin and piano. British Columbia native, **Jeremy Ludwig** recently graduated with a Masters of Music from the University of Toronto where he appeared many times on the stage of the University's MacMillan Theatre, most recently as Don Inigo Gomez in Ravel's *L'heure espagnol*. Other opera credits include the role of Schaunard in *La Bohème*; Guglielmo in *Così fan tutte*, Harlekin in *Ariadne auf Naxos*, The King of Scotland in Handel's *Ariodante*, Belcore in Donizetti's *L'elisir d'amore*, Marullo in *Rigoletto* (Brampton Lyric Opera), Achilla in Handel's *Giulio Cesare* (Halifax Summer Opera Workshop) and Krusina in Smetana's *The Bartered Bride* (Opera NUOVA). Jeremy is as comfortable in the world of oratorio and recital as he is on the operatic stage appearing with the Handel Society in White Rock, British Columbia, the East York Choir, the Talisker Players and Toronto's Tryptych Ensemble
